

## iPad Info: GRMN 320

- A user's guide from Apple on the iPad provides extensive information on iPad basics and on particular functions and apps.
- The iPads are for use during the semester only and will need to be returned at the end of the semester
- To type Umlauts on the iPad, hold down the vowel you want to type and choose the umlauted vowel from the pop-up that appears above the vowel - same procedure to type ß. Alternatively, you can change the keyboard – see Settings > General > Keyboards > Add new keyboard... > German
- You are free to upload apps to your iPad - to do so you will need a free Apple ID: click on the App Store icon.
- It will be advantageous to have a pair of earbuds or headphones to use with the iPad
